Clark's Corner

Depending on one's taxonomy, this is Cattleya Breautiana (loddigesii 'Streeter's Choice' FCC/AOS x violacea 'Muse' FCC/ AOS) or Cattleya Zachary Hodes (harrisoniana x violacea). The patent (US PP8541 P) lists one parent as Cattleya loddigesii var. Harrisoniana Streeter's Choice FCC/AOS.

The Kew database accepts harrisoniana so Zachary Hodes would be a good name. Zachary Hodes was registered by LeonGlicenstein in 2007, Breautiana by Maron in 1897. Francisco Miranda made a very compelling case for separating harrisoniana and loddigesii and 'Streeters Choice' is very much in the harrisoniana mold. His analysis would favor harrisoniana as a parent species and the features of this clone support harrisoniana.



Regardless, this paring of two of the finest clones of each species has resulted in a spectacularly charming child. Acquired from Jewell Orchids of Colbert, Georgia as a small seedling.
