## October's Guest Speaker



Kim Feddersen of Fair Orchids in Maplewood, NJ will present "Slip-pers - Mostly Paphs" as the educational speaker for our October 20th meeting. His talk will be an overview of the 5 genera, in-depth look at Paphiopedium sub-genera, plus growing conditions for Paphs, Phrags & Mexipedium.

Kim grew up in Denmark, where his dad had a retail orchid nursery(Orkide Kultur). He started working in the nursery after school when he was 15, and continued till he left for the US 9 years later. His dad's first love was paphiopedilums (cypripediums to him), and that bug turned out to be infectious. Those were the days of wild collected plants, but his dad did some hybridizing also, including Vandas, which kindled Kim's second orchid passion.

Kim has grown Orchids as a hobby grower for about 20 years starting in windows, moving to lights in the base-ment, and finally into a greenhouse, where his collection today numbers some 1500+ plants, mostly Phaphiopedilum and Vandaceous, but also ranging into Cattleyas, Aussie Dendrobiums, pendulous Cymbidiums & Lycastes. He does a little breeding in Phaphs (complex & tea cup types) and miniature Vandaceous, with emphasis on Neofinetia falcate & Ascocentrum hybrids.

# Clark's Corner

## **Paphiopedilum sanderianum DSC\_4726**

One essential trait of orchid growers is patience. In 1995, I got six seedlings of *Paphiopedilum sanderianum*, a species thought extinct back in the 1950s and 60s. Three seedlings decided to bloom simultaneously 21 years later. The three other, in an identical hanging basket just ten feet away decided not to bloom.

The plants were acquired from Hans and Johanna Burkhardt along Noyo Creek, California. They were great orchid growers who moved the field along.
